Among other things, Indian stalls especially focussed upon One District One Product(ODOP) to support bringing the products of each district on global stage and the millets to mark the International Year of Millets.

The audience was thrilled by the dance performance from Children of Yashoda Group and the team of Vina Fan.

The event concluded with appreciation of the progress in India-ASEAN relations and the resolve for further strengthening it.
